1. **Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 3:16pm by Rebecca Hall. Quorum was present.
2. **Citizens Communications:** No citizen communications.
3. **Approval of Minutes:** The August 2017 meeting minutes were reviewed and no corrections were offered. Minutes will be filed as submitted.
4. **PTA Report:** Katy Heisterman reported that PTA sponsored Screenagers documentary showing is coming up on September 28th followed by a coffee talk facilitated by the Kiker counselors a week later to discuss the film with parents. There will be a special PTA meeting to discuss the upcoming AISD Bond and to vote on the PTA taking a position on the Bond. Kiker will be having a 25th birthday celebration on October 11th, parents and families welcome.
5. **Election of Officers:** Mrs. Haschke volunteered to be the Teacher Co-Chair and Rebecca Hall the Parent Co-Chair. There were no other nominations. All approved the Co-chair nominees.

6. Principal's Report, Dr. Lori Schneider:

- a. Needs Assessment and CIP Overview: Dr. Schneider offered the CIP Overview and timeline. The website for review and a reader password will be sent out. Suggestions will be due to Rebecca by October 20th. Kiker school accountability data is available on the quicklinks data section of the AISD website.
- b. Updated CIP Professional Development: Dr. Schneider mentioned that the Professional Development Plan has been updated and approved.
- c. Enrollment/Staffing: 1,100 students as of today; Kinder: 204 students, 10 teachers; 1st: 183 students, 9 teachers; 2nd: 154 students, 7 teachers, with approval to add one more; 3rd: 173 students, 8 teachers; 4th: 188 students, 9 teachers; 5th: 172 students, 6 teachers.

7. Other CAC Business:

- a. Overcrowding overview and Bond implications: The AISD Bond package will be on the November ballot and includes updates for Kiker and a new SW Elementary school in Avaña to relieve overcrowding at Kiker and Baranoff. The new SW Elem. School is slated to open in 2020 and is expected to hold 520 students at capacity with a max of 600. The new school will help to bring Kiker's attendance levels down from 1,100 to a range of 700-800. Boundary lines will be redrawn by Dec. 2019. If the Bond does not pass, there could be boundary line re-draws and grade-level reassignments.

8. **Adjourn:** Rebecca Hall motioned to adjourn the meeting, Mrs. Haschke seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 4:20 pm.
